## WHY YOU SHOULD **APPLY**

If you are considering graduate studies in the near future, or are currently enrolled in a graduate program, you will be evaluating your financial situation and your ability to pay for your graduate education.

If you are admitted to Carleton University, you will automatically be considered for scholarships and other funding such as teaching or research assistantships. In addition, there are major external scholarships for which you may be eligible that can help you pay for your education.

This brochure lists some of the external scholarships which are available to you, as well as eligibility requirements, application information and deadlines. ## **BEGINNING YOUR APPLICATION**

- 1. Determine the awards for which you are eligible to apply.
- 2. Read all the application instructions carefully.
- 3. Create a schedule to get everything done by the deadline.
- 4. Request letters of recommendation from professors or supervisors who know you well and can speak to your abilities.
- 5. Request official transcripts from previous universities well in advance, especially if they are outside North America.
- 6. Attend a workshop for the scholarship if one is being held — check the Important Dates section of our website for dates, times and locations.
